

**SCHEME FOR AWARD OF STIPEND TO THE SCHEDULED TRIBE
STUDENTS OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH PURSUING HIGHER & TECHNICAL
EDUCATION**

RULES AND REGULATIONS, 2012

**I. SHORT TITLE
EXTENT AND
COMMENCEMENT**

- a) This Scheme may be called the Arunachal Pradesh State Stipend Scheme 2012
- b) It extends only to the Scheduled Tribe students of Arunachal Pradesh.
- c) It shall come into force w.e.f. 1st April'2012.

II. INTERPRETATION: - In these rules unless the context otherwise requires:-

- a) "Government" means the Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
- b) "Governor" means the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh
- c) "Scheduled Tribe" shall have the meaning assigned to them in Part III- Arunachal Pradesh under the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Union Territories, Order 1951 of the Constitution of India (or as ammended from time to time)
- d) "Recognised institution" means institutions recognized either by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh or by the Govt. of India or by other State/UT Governments.
- e) "Secretary (Education)" means Secretary to the Government of Arunachal Pradesh in charge of Education Department.
- f) "Full time employment" means employment of a person on regular payment, either on temporary or permanent basis.
- g) "Head of Institution" means the head of institution like Principal, Registrar, Director etc. in which the stipendiary is studying.
- h) "Sanctioning Authority" referred to in the Scheme" means the Head of office authorized by the State Government to sanction stipend under the scheme.
- i) "Prescribed" means prescribed by rules under this scheme.
- j) "Stipend" means the monthly allowance payable to the students under this scheme.

- k) "Initial Book Grant" means amount payable to students for purchase of books for the 1st year.
 - l) "Subsequent Book-grant" means amount payable for purchase of books in subsequent years.

III. OBJECT:-

The object of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to Scheduled Tribe students of Arunachal Pradesh so as to enable them to pursue various courses of Higher studies approved by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh..

IV. CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:-

- 1) The stipend will be admissible to students who belong to Scheduled Tribes of the State as notified by the Central /State Government and are permanent resident of Arunachal Pradesh.
- 2) Scheduled Tribe students who are in full-time employment are not eligible for award of stipend.
- 3) A student who fails in a class for a particular course of study/stream and gets re-admitted in the same level of study for a different course/stream shall not be eligible for the award of stipend for that class.
- 4) A Girl student who fails in a class may be allowed one time stipend for same class in the next year with specific recommendation from the Head of Institution.
- 5) Students against whom disciplinary action is taken shall not be eligible for stipend.
- 6) Students whose attendance is below 75% in any month (unless for certified reasons of health or bereavement), shall not be eligible for award of stipend.
- 7) Students who pursue their studies through correspondence course or distance education mode shall not be eligible for stipend.
- 8) Students pursuing their studies in institutions not recognized by the State or Central Regulators like UGC, AICTE, MCI, DCI, BCI, CCH. etc., shall not be eligible for award of stipend.

V. GENERAL CONDITION: - FOR AWARD OF STIPEND

1. The grant or continuance of stipend is subject to the satisfactory progress and good conduct of the student for the particular course for which he has applied for stipend. If it is reported by the Head of the Institution or local Administration that a stipend holder, by reason of his/her own act of default has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strike or political activities irregularity in attendance etc, the stipend shall be discontinued.
2. The Government reserves the right to either cancel the stipend or stop or with-hold further payment to any student for such period as it may deem fit.
3. The stipend will not be admissible for the period when the institution is closed for vacation.

- 4. Stipend will be payable from the date of admission for a particular course provided. But if the student takes admission after 20th day of a month, the stipend shall be admissible from the next month onward.
- 5. The conditions for the award of stipend may be changed at any time at the discretion of the State Government without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
- 6. A stipend holder under this scheme will not avail stipend/scholarship from any other source. If any other stipend/scholarship is awarded to a student, he/she can opt for either of the two, which ever is beneficial to him/her and should surrender the other.
- 7. The stipend is not tenable for subsidiary/additional course such as L.L.B. with M.A.etc. The student who undergoes of two courses is given stipend for one course only.

VII PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:-

- 1 Application for award of stipend should be submitted in the prescribed form within the date notified by the State Government.
- 2 All applications must accompany by one attested copy of the following.
 - (a) Attested copy of Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe Certificate
 - (b) Attested copy of Mark sheet of last examination passed.
- 3 Application complete in all respect shall be submitted through the Head of the Institution to the concern sanctioning authority.
- 4 Incomplete applications or application received after the prescribed date will summarily be rejected.

VIII PROCEDURE FOR DISBURSEMENT OF STIPEND:-

- i) The head of the Institution/ shall draw and disburse stipend to students in respect of whom stipend are sanctioned.
- ii) Stipend in respect of students studying outside Arunachal Pradesh shall be drawn by the sanctioning authority in the form of Demand Draft and dispatch to the Heads of the Institution for disbursement to the student.
